

## **Guidelines for Resuming Assembly Worship at Lord of Life**

June 1, 2020

- We will offer multiple worship services of up to 50 people on Sunday at 8:00am, 9:30am, and 11:00am. The 8:00am service will be live streamed and made available online.
- Those at high risk for infection should consider continuing to worship from home. Everyone should self screen for symptoms at home before attending
- An electronic sign-up will be sent for people to reserve seating for the service they plan to attend. Each service will be limited to 50 people.
- The following social distancing measures will be implemented:
  - In order to keep everyone safe, we ask everyone to wear a mask and keep six feet distance
  - We ask everyone to only enter church through the front doors. Doors will be propped open to minimize hand contact
  - We ask that only one person use the bathroom at a time
  - Seating in the church will be spaced using empty rows of pews between rows of worshippers, and six feet distance between family units/ individuals sitting in the same pew.
  - Hymnals, paper bulletins, friendship registers, and offering plates will not be used. The entire worship service will be displayed on the video screen
  - We will distribute communion by family and/or individuals maintaining six feet distance, and strive to be as touch free as possible
- We ask everyone to limit their facility use to the entryway, sanctuary, bathroom and cry room. The school, gym, and nursery will be closed
- After worship, we ask everyone to leave the church immediately, but you may socialize outside the church following social distancing practices.
- Volunteers will clean/disinfect all commonly used surfaces between services.

We understand that some people may not feel comfortable with these arrangements and may want to wait longer before coming back to church. We ask everyone to be respectful of others and understanding of various perspectives pertaining to these issues and measures.
